



Addresses for Amalgam Separator Installation Forms

NYS regulations with a full compliance date of May 12, 2008, require the installation and use of dental amalgam separators at dental facilities. Dental facilities **NOT** required to install an amalgam separator are those where the specialties of orthodontics, periodontics, prosthodontics, and oral and maxillofacial surgery are exclusively performed. All amalgam separators must be properly sized for the volume and flow of the dental facility amalgam wastewater, and operated and maintained in accordance to manufacturer's specifications and recommendations (description and date of all maintenance performed on the amalgam separator must be retained for 3 years).

Amalgam separator installation forms must be submitted to the sewage treatment works or sewer authority and must contain dental facility name and location, including street address and municipal subdivision, i.e. city, town, or village, telephone number, type of amalgam separator installed, manufacturer's model number, unit specifications, date the unit was placed in service and the number of chairs units served by the separator (retain for the life of the separator).

Dental facilities within **Monroe County** with the **exception of the Village and Town of Webster and the Village of Honeoye Falls** can submit their Amalgam Separator Installation Form to:
