Biography

Sean McLaren, DDS, MBA, is a Professor of Dentistry and Pediatrics at the University of Rochester’s Eastman Institute for Oral Health (EIOH). He currently serves as EIOH’s Medical Director and Chief Officer of Quality, Compliance, and Safety. Previously, Dr. McLaren served as Chairman and Residency Program Director of the Pediatric Dentistry Residency Program at EIOH.

Dr. McLaren represents District 2 on the American Dental Association’s Council on Access, Advocacy, and Prevention and is a past president of the Seventh District Dental Society. His professional interests include access to care, quality improvement, and teledentistry.

A lifelong Rochester native, Dr. McLaren graduated from McQuaid Jesuit, Canisius College, the SUNY Buffalo School of Dental Medicine, and the University of Rochester’s Simon Business School.

Course Description

This course provides a practical overview of pediatric dentistry for the general dentist, focusing on key concepts and clinical considerations when caring for infants and children. Participants will gain an understanding of pediatric oral health, caries prevention and management, restorative treatment, dental trauma, pulp therapy, and effective behavior management techniques.

Learning Objectives:

At the end of the course, the participant should be able to:

- Explain the fundamentals of infant oral health and preventive care.
- Describe caries risk assessment and its role in pediatric dental care.
- Identify restorative treatment options and basic pulp therapy techniques for primary teeth.
- Understand the basic guiding principles for evaluating and managing dental trauma in children.
- Incorporate basic behavior management techniques into dental practice when treating pediatric patients.
