Dr. Andrew Coniglio

Dr. Andrew Coniglio is a board-certified otolaryngologist from Rochester, NY. He earned a Bachelor of Music from the University of Michigan, graduating with honors, and later transitioned to medicine thanks to his interest in vocal arts. He received his medical degree from the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry and was honored with induction into Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Medical Society. He completed his residency in otolaryngology and fellowship training in head and neck oncology and microvascular free flap reconstruction at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Dr. Coniglio specializes in cancers of the head and neck and reconstruction of surgical defects through microvascular free flap surgery. He also specializes in thyroid and parathyroid surgery, sinus and skull base surgery, laryngology, and sleep surgery, including the hypoglossal nerve stimulator. Dr. Coniglio has published in many leading journals and is a member of the American Head and Neck Society and the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery.

Within Rochester Regional Health and the community, he collaborates regularly with radiation and medical oncology, dental and maxillofacial specialists, speech and language pathologists, imaging professionals, and other fellowshiptrained surgeons to provide comprehensive care for patients. Cases are presented weekly at a multidisciplinary head and neck tumor board involving many of these teams to devise an individualized plan for each patient.

Dr. Coniglio values not only the medical complexity of each patient but the psychosocial aspects that define them. He particularly cherishes the lifelong relationships with patients.

Course Description

This presentation will examine the serious health effects of obstructive sleep apnea and the important collaboration between dentistry, sleep medicine, and ENT. He will review the latest surgical treatment options available for all levels of severity, equipping you with the knowledge to better advise and support your patients in their care journey.

Learning Objectives

- Briefly discuss the complex pathophysiology of obstructive sleep apnea and its downstream health damages.
- Understand the common symptoms and physical exam findings of obstructive sleep apnea and how dentists play an important role.
- Generate a thoughtful approach to the surgical options available to a patient when a CPAP and/or oral appliance has failed.
- Learn how the hypoglossal nerve stimulator (Inspire®) functions, with its ensuing benefit on quality of life, and identify the optimal patient population using outcomes data.
