### **Biography**

### **Course Description**

Acute pain of pulpal origin can be debilitating for a patient. This course is designed to help dentists triage patients presenting with irreversible pulpitis or necrotic teeth causing pain. We will discuss the diagnosis of acute pain as well as pharmacologic and treatment options to manage these dental emergencies.

### **Learning Objectives**

- Diagnose the pulpal and periapical status of a tooth.
- Understand pharmacologic options to deal with pulpitis or abscess.
- Identify treatment options for the management of endodontic emergencies, including I&D, pulpotomy, and pulpectomy.
