Biography

His lectures focus on restorative dentistry, emphasizing individualized approaches to periodontal therapy, implant dentistry, laser applications, and treatment strategies for the growing geriatric population.

Course Description

For 70 plus years, diagnostics in dentistry has been driven by your eyes, explorer, 2D x-rays, and periodontal probes. Truth be told, your eyes are the most valuable, and everything else is often "a flip of the coin!" In fact, most diagnostics are not that sensitive and routinely are "reactive" in their approach. This course will dive into how to incorporate far more sensitive and specific modalities into your recall and initial exams and give you far better opportunities to diagnose your patients in both a predictive manner and a superior reactive manner.

Learning Objectives

- Evaluate the limitations of traditional diagnostic methods and understand why they often result in delayed or reactive treatment.
- Incorporate AI-enhanced 2D radiographic analysis to improve diagnostic accuracy, patient education, and case acceptance.
- Explain the evolving role of full-mouth radiographic series (FMX) and how emerging technologies are changing diagnostic protocols.

- Integrate near-infrared imaging and fluorescence technologies into routine recall and comprehensive examinations.
- Identify early non-cavitated enamel lesions and understand the clinical application of Curodont® Repair as a minimally invasive treatment option.
- Develop efficient workflows for modern recall and initial examinations that support earlier diagnosis and comprehensive oral health care.
- Recognize the role of saliva and genetic testing in assessing disease risk and advancing a preventive, patient-centered approach to oral health.
- Apply evidence-based diagnostic technologies through real-world clinical cases to improve patient outcomes and practice efficiency.
